Candidate Acknowledgements

By signing this document, I acknowledge that I have been given an opportunity to learn about The Praxis Society and understand the following:

- The Praxis Society is guided by six pillars: Character, Fellowship, Achievement, Service, Discipline, and Growth.
- The standard determines membership - not gender, profession, wealth, status, background, or social connections.
- Candidate status does not guarantee admission to membership. Membership is granted only through the Society's approved process.
- Candidacy is intended to derive its rigor from punctuality, preparation, service, reflection, consistency, learning, and contribution. Hazing is prohibited.
- Members are expected to participate consistently, keep commitments, contribute to the Society and wider community, and give and receive constructive feedback in good faith.
- Annual membership dues are initially \$50 CAD and may be adjusted in accordance with the Bylaws. Approved hardship arrangements may be available. Payment of dues does not purchase or guarantee membership.
- Society events and activities must be safe, lawful, inclusive, and consistent with the Charter, Bylaws, and Membership & Traditions Code. No person may be pressured to consume alcohol, cannabis, or another intoxicating substance as a condition of candidacy, participation, fellowship, celebration, or induction.
- The Society may maintain reasonable membership, governance, financial, and historical records for legitimate organizational purposes, with access to sensitive personal information limited to legitimate organizational need.
- If admitted, I will be expected to protect the dignity and reputation of the Society and to use its name, crest, pin, and other symbols responsibly.

The Member's Commitment

- I will seek achievement without sacrificing character.
- I will support fellow members without blindly defending wrongdoing.
- I will accept accountability before demanding it from others.
- I will serve without requiring recognition.
- I will respect people whose backgrounds and beliefs differ from mine.
- I will continue to learn, improve, and contribute.
- I will remember that membership represents responsibility rather than status.
- I will put principles into action.
